Five Year History for Top 10 Trade Lanes for Imports via Savannah (Fiscal Year)

Last updated: August 2024 (GPA Marketing)

Detail Summary:

- Southeast Asia was the fastest growing trade lane for imports via Savannah between Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20) and FY24, increasing by 187,089 TEUs.
- Other trade lanes with rapid growth between FY20 and FY24 were Northeast Asia (+97,318 TEUs), Southern Asia/Indian Subcontinent (+81,171 TEUs), Mediterranean (+36,259 TEUs), and Africa (+6,210 TEUs).
